**Check in** suggestion: Have each person, in 2 or 3 sentences answer the question – How did you come today?

**Watch** the service, engage as much as you are able and comfortable.

**Discuss and Pray:** Once the Sunday service has completed, use any portions of the guide to facilitate discussion and prayer time. It is important to honour the agreed meeting time. Further discussion, prayer, connecting can be arranged after concluding the gathering.
